Malcolm E. Hiday, 97, of Ossian, passed away Wednesday evening, March 27, 2019, at Ossian Health & Rehab. Center.

Malcolm was born on September 8, 1921 in Noblesville, Indiana to Harry & Mary (Smith) Hiday. He graduated from Petroleum High School in 1939.

On January 13, 1940, Malcolm and Justine L. (Davenport) Hiday were married. They recently celebrated their 79th wedding anniversary.

Malcolm was a lifelong dairy farmer. Malcolm and Justine lived in Pennville and ran the family dairy operation until they moved to Ossian in 1964. He continued his dairy farm until he retired at the age of 65. After retirement, they enjoyed spending the winters in Fort Myers Beach, FL., and Malcolm became a full-time golfer and an avid fisherman. He was a member of the Ossian United Methodist Church.

Survivors include his wife Justine, of Ossian along with five children; Larry (Nedra) Hiday of Bluffton, Sonja DeHoff of Bluffton, Dixie "Diane" (Thomas) Hedges of Gallatin, TN., Mary Lou (Gary) Adams of Leesburg and Cheryl (Ted) Martz of Ossian, along with 16 grandchildren and 38 great-grandchildren.

Malcolm is preceded in death by a grandchild, a great-grandchild and siblings; Joe Hiday, Juanita Martin, Chester Hiday, Harold "Dutch" Hiday and Marilee Blankenbecker.

I remember coming to your house to stay all night. Your dad was always working no matter what time of day. Cheryl sometimes had to go help and I would tag along with her to the barn. What a different kind of home place than where I was raised.

Cheryl and I were friends from the first day she came to school at Ossian. When we got our driver's licenses we would drive each other back and forth to school so no more riding the bus. We had some really good times with the Norwell band (we used tanning crème so our legs would turn brown before the parade and used hair spray to keep our hair in place), the Wells County 4-H camp (to meet boys), working at the Ossian drive-in and just sharing fun times with each other. I remember Cheryl babysitting for Sonja whenever she was needed. It seems like she made more babysitting cash than I did.

When I tried to twirl a baton, Mary Lou was the instructor. We shared many good times during my lessons where I learned a lot and it was not about twirling (like stitching the shoulder seams of tank tops so they would not be so low cut in the front). During the summer we would go for long bicycle rides without a particular map planned. One day we ended up in Poe. Water bottles were not around yet so we made sure we had change with us so we could make a pop machine purchase. I never knew cars could go so fast until I rode with Mary Lou. During a sleep over at the Hiday's house, we chose up teams and tried to out-fool the other team. Mary Lou was so good. She showed us how to put Saran Wrap on the toilet seats and on the doorways between rooms. It wasn't fun for the other team but we loved it.

Well take care and again know we are thinking of you.
