Paul R. Krummen, 65 of rural Bluffton, passed away on Thursday morning, September 19, 2019, at his residence.

Paul was born on March 10, 1954 in Bluffton, Indiana to Ervin A. & LaVera K. (Gehring) Krummen. He was the Salutatorian of his class at Norwell High School in 1972. After working at Franklin Electric for 4 years, Paul completed a 4-year Electrical Apprenticeship with the IBEW Union - Fort Wayne Local 305 and later served as an instructor in the program. He was a journeyman electrician with a Master's license. He worked out of the Electrical Union Hall for over 30 years, and as a Supervisor for an Electrical Consulting Business for 5 years. He retired at the age of 62.

An avid hiker, Paul enjoyed visiting and hiking the National Parks. One of his favorite places was Mesa, AZ, where he spent many winters. He was a sports car enthusiast. He lived on the family farm where he enjoyed gardening and working in the orchard. He could be described as a self-made gentleman farmer!

Survivors include his brother Dale (Rosa) Krummen and sister, Patricia (Robert) Catalino, along with two nieces; Bethany Domanowski and Monica Richards, and two nephews; David Charles and Brian Krummen.
