“ Spencer, I just saw you at my house last Friday looking for the wand to your water pressure sprayer.

Not a CLUE that you were in a rough place. If I'd seen a sign, I would have asked you to sit down with me and talk. Mitch Maddox told me only a couple hours ago . . . and we wept.

I know first hand what your parents are experiencing. Heartbreaking. Just like my son, Casey Montgomery, I know you are safe with God.

The following from Norman Vincent Peale has given me peace and understanding during the last 7 years, 2 months and 27 days:

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Modified excerpt from Norman Vincent Peale – “When Someone Takes His Own Life”

“A young man died by his own hand, a service for him was conducted by his pastor, the Rev. Warren Stevens. What he said that day expresses, far more eloquently than I can, the message that I am trying to convey. Here are some of his words:

“He died on his own battlefield. He was killed in action fighting a civil war. He fought against adversaries that were as real to him as his casket is real to us. They were powerful adversaries. They took toll of his energies and endurance. They exhausted what was left of his courage and strength. These adversaries overwhelmed him. And it appeared that he had lost the war. But did he? I see a host of victories that he has won!

“For one thing, he has won our admiration, because even if he lost the war, we give him credit for his bravery on the battlefield. And we give him credit for the courage and pride and hope that he used as his weapons as long as he could.

“We shall remember not his death, but his daily victories gained through his kindnesses and thoughtfulness, through his love for family and friends.

“We shall remember not his last day of defeat, but we shall remember the many days that he was victorious over overwhelming odds. We shall remember not the years we thought

he had left, but the intensity with which he lived the years that he had.

“Only God knows what this child of His suffered in the silent skirmishes that took place in his soul. Our consolation is that God does know, and understands.”

“ It's been said by some religions, those who end their own life are condemned to [****]. I believe in a merciful loving God. Our Casey Montgomery lived 11 years with Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) before ending his life.

This is part of a conversation Casey Montgomery and I had - on my first Mother's Day after Casey died:

From Casey:

"I made it Mom! I made it! It is incredible here!

No more Traumatic Brain Injury Mom. The emotional pain I wrestled too often for too long is gone. The crazy chaos in my mind turned to bliss. My soul is overjoyed; my spirit is free.

I was with you when you were on the deck staring up at the clear blue sky the morning after I died. You watched the airplane release fuel and watched them stop the release; then you watched two thin clouds float into the fuel line and pause to form a Cross - that was for you.

I felt the peace that came over your heart as you grasped the power of that sign. Your thoughts were right Momma; that was a sign from me and God. We were letting you know I made it."

Casey graduated 2008; Spencer graduated 2010 - both from Southern Wells. Casey and Spencer are Facebook friends. And Casey and Spencer are both in Heaven with God.
