



## A. Deanna Wietholter

September 24, 1940 - July 29, 2008

A. Deanna Wietholter, 67 of Westfield, Indiana (formerly of Bluffton, IN) passed away on Tuesday July 29, 2008 at St. Vincent's Hospital in Indianapolis.

Mrs. Wietholter was born on September 24, 1940 in Piqua, Ohio to John A. & Helen Irene (Hildebrand) Brumbaugh. She graduated from Piqua Central High School in 1958 and went on to study at Miami Jacob's Business School in Dayton.

On May 19, 1962 in Piqua, she married Robert "Bob" W. Wietholter.

Deanna along with her husband owned & operated the Country Squire Florist in Bluffton, IN from 1970 to 2001. She worked as the office manager and handled the bookkeeping for the store. She was also a homemaker.

Deanna was formerly a member of the First United Methodist Church in Bluffton and was a member of St. Luke's United Methodist Church in Indianapolis, IN.

She is survived by her husband of 46 years; sons: W. Kyle (Carol Hauswald) Wietholter and J. Garrett (Lana Oman) Wietholter, both of Zionsville, Indiana. She is also survived by two grandchildren (Michael W. and Eric L.) and one sister; Mrs. Jonathan "Rita" Laufman of Troy, Ohio and was preceded in death by her sister Mrs. Peter "Marilyn" Brown of Bacus, MN.
