October 13, 1918 - November 13, 2010

Agnes J. Shane, 92, a resident of the Markle Health and Rehabilitation Center, died there at 9:23 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 13, 2010.

Mrs. Shane was a retired General Electric employee. She was a member of the Mulberry Wesleyan Church. She was a member and past president of the Women's Missionary Society and taught Sunday School for many years. She was a lifelong resident of Wells County and attended Bluffton High School. She was born Oct. 13, 1918, in Liberty Center, to Thomas Maddux and Lunda Tarr Maddux. She married Lavon L. Shane Dec. 24, 1938, in Bluffton; her husband died Jan. 31, 2003.

Survivors include a son, Don E. (Nancy) Shane of Bluffton; a daughter, Karen (Jack) Barcus of Bluffton; a granddaughter, Tammy (Tim) Garwood of Springfield, Ohio; four grandsons, David (Nikki) Barcus of Poneto, Richard (Tammy) Shane of Bluffton, Jeffery (Amy) Shane of Bluffton, and Michael (Michelle) Shane of Ossian; and 16 great-grandchildren.
