Arleen Harvey, 74, of Bluffton, died at 7:00 a.m. Thursday, July 12, 2007, at her residence.

Born to Joseph A. and Bertha (Wertzberger) Sowards on January 10, 1934, Mrs. Harvey married Don Harvey on December 26, 1964; he survives.

A graduate of Bluffton High School, St. Joe Hospital of X-Ray Technology and Fort Wayne Community Schools of Licensed Practical Nursing, Mrs. Harvey worked at Duemling Clinic, Wells Community Hospital and the offices of Doctors Brickley, Mead and Hamilton. She also did Home Health Care after retiring and worked at Bi-County Services. She was a member of the Wells Community Health Foundation Auxiliary and the First Presbyterian Church.
