



Arthur V. Gahman

January 26, 1917 - September 2, 2009

Arthur V. Gahman, 92, a resident of rural Craigville, died at 11:55 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 2, 2009, at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Mr. Gahman was a retired employee of Franklin Electric in Bluffton. He had been employed as a greeter at Wal-Mart in Bluffton for eight years. He was also a lifelong farmer.

A lifelong resident of Wells County, he was a graduate of Lancaster High School and furthered his education in the School of Agriculture at Purdue University. He attended Hope Missionary Church.

Mr. Gahman was born Jan. 26, 1917, in Wells County, to Martin and Ethel Warthman Gahman. He married Martha Harris Oct. 29, 1946; his wife survives in Craigville.

Also surviving are four daughters, Ruth (Kenneth) Parrish of Decatur, Joanna (Tom) Bush of Monroeville, Donna (Ed) Mygrant of Huntington, and Tina (John F.) Parrish of Decatur; a son, Chris (Angie) Gahman of Uniondale; and nine grandchildren, four step-grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Robert Gahman, and two sisters, Alice Wilkinson and Vera Montgomery.

Calling will be from 4 to 8 p.m. Monday at the Thoma/Rich, Chaney and Lemler Funeral Home, Bluffton. Services will be held at the funeral home at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday with Pastor Phil Harris officiating. Burial will be at the Oakland Cemetery at Craigville.
