Bernard L. "Bernie" Osborn, 73, of Bluffton, died Wednesday, May 9, 2007, 8 p.m., at Bluffton Regional Medical Center. Born March 26, 1934, in Wells County, he was the son of Leita (Smith) and John Howard Osborn. He married Carolyn A. (Keel) on Feb. 1, 1957, in Huntington; she survives in Bluffton. He graduated from East Union Township School, Wells County, in 1952. He graduated from Purdue University in 1963 with an A.A.S.M.E.T. He was employed with Franklin Electric Company as a Journeyman Tool & Die Maker and with Bomar and Magnavox as a Model Maker, retiring in 1997. He was a 50+ year member of Masonic Lodge and Scottish Rite; member of York Rite and Mizpah Shrine Temple, Amateur Radio Club, Hoosier Cruisers R.V. Club, and A.B.A.T.E. Also surviving are his son, Michael "Mike" (wife Linda) Osborn of Austin, Texas; siblings, Mrs. Robert (Lillian) Krider of Fort Wayne, Ms. Rose Williams of Bluffton, Mrs. Donald K.
