Bessie M. Nicholson, 91, of Bluffton died at 7:45 a.m., Thursday, February 18, 2010 at Bluffton Regional Medical Center. Bessie was a 38 year employee of General Electric Company of Fort Wayne. Prior to going to work at General Electric, She owned and operated her own beauty shop and in her early years, Bessie worked at the Glove Factory and the Dime Store. She was the oldest living member of Epworth United Methodist Church of Bluffton.
