Betty Lou Dunwiddie, 83 of rural Bluffton, passed away on Sunday morning, July 24, 2022, at River Terrace in Bluffton.

Betty was born on October 5, 1938, in Bluffton to Ernest & Ethel (Barlett) Lesh and graduated from Rockcreek High School with the class of 1956.
