



## Beverly J. Skurner

January 7, 1936 - October 23, 2010

Beverly J. Skurner, 74, of Bluffton, died at 5:10 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 23, 2010, at the Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Mrs. Skurner was a 1954 graduate of Rockcreek High School. She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church, where she was active in the women's group. She was a homemaker. She was a member of a quilting circle, and in addition to being a quilter, she was an artist.

She was born Jan. 7, 1936, in Wells County, to Homer O. Edris and Alta E. Sheets Edris. She married Thomas B. Skurner Dec. 6, 1958, in Bluffton; her husband survives.

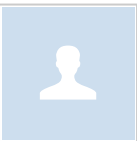

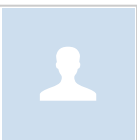
