May 31, 1958 - February 13, 2015

Bruce E. Fuller, 56 of Bluffton and a resident of Findlay, Ohio, went home to be with his heavenly Father at 5:20 p.m. Friday, February 13, 2015, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Bruce was born on May 31, 1958 in Bluffton, Indiana to Larry Clay Fuller and Marcia (Motz) Fuller Liddy. He graduated from Elmhurst High School in 1977. He served his country in the United States Air Force and worked at the Lowes Home Improvement Distribution Center in Findley, Ohio for the last 10 years. He was a member of the Upper Room Church of God, where he served on the mission Committee and participated in the Easter Cantata's.

Survivors include his mother Marcia of Keystone, Indiana and his father Larry of Leipsic, Ohio along with siblings: Beth (Ernie) Heubach of Wallkill, New York, Brian Fuller of Ossian, Brent (Terri) Fuller of Fort Wayne along with 8 nieces and nephews.
