

Calvin E. Towne

May 19, 1929 - April 17, 2017

Calvin E. Towne, 87, of Bluffton passed away on Monday evening, April 17, 2017, at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Fort Wayne.

He was born on May 19, 1929 in Xenia, Ohio to John H. & Nellie (Pickel) Towne. On December 16, 1950 in Rochester, New York, Cal & Marian I. (Lindsley) Towne were married. They have enjoyed 66 years together.

Cal served his country in the United States Army from 1946 to 1949. He worked as an Engineer at Franklin Electric in Bluffton for 18 years, retiring in 1991. He was a professor at Ivy Tech in Fort Wayne for over 20 years. Cal was a master electrician. He owned and operated Town Electric in Bluffton for over 35+, working with the City of Bluffton on many projects.

He was a faithful member of the Bluffton First Church of the Nazarene and was very active in the Work in Witness Mission Projects in many different countries. He enjoyed going on mission trips to build churches, overseeing the electrical part.

Survivors include his wife Marian of Markle along with children: Calvin (Linnea) Towne of Springboro, Ohio, Gerald W. (Theresa) Towne of Markle, Steve (Mary) Towne of Poneto, Carol (Ruben) Rodriguez of Justin, Texas, Sharon (Randy) Eskew of Fort Wayne, Joanne (Scott) Landers of Bluffton and Susie (Ken) Towne-Powell of Ossian. He is also survived by 34 grandchildren and 37 great-grandchildren.

He is preceded in death by a daughter Marian E. Girod in 2002.

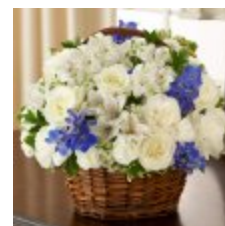
