June 22, 1943 - June 4, 2015

Carl Thompson 71 of Bluffton passed away at 10:13 a.m. Thursday, June 4, 2015 at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

He was born on June 22, 1943 in Wells County to Roy D. & Minnie (Wolf) Thompson. He graduated from Lancaster High School in 1962. Carl served honorably in the Indiana National Guard from 1964 to 1970, and was activated into the United States Army from 1964 to 1965. He worked at Corning Glass Works for 19 years and Eagle-Picher in Huntington for 20 years and various local part time jobs before he retired. Carl was a loving family man that enjoyed John Deere tractors and was a member of the Warren Tractor Club and Wheels of Yesteryear and was an avid coon hunter.

On June 25, 1984, Carl and Rose (Spencer) were married in Bluffton. Rose survives in Bluffton along with children: Tim (Julie) Thompson of Poneto, Todd (Karen) Thompson of Bluffton, Teri Yates of Norwalk, Ohio, Curt (Nikki) Thompson of Ossian and Cindy Stiles of Pendleton, IN.

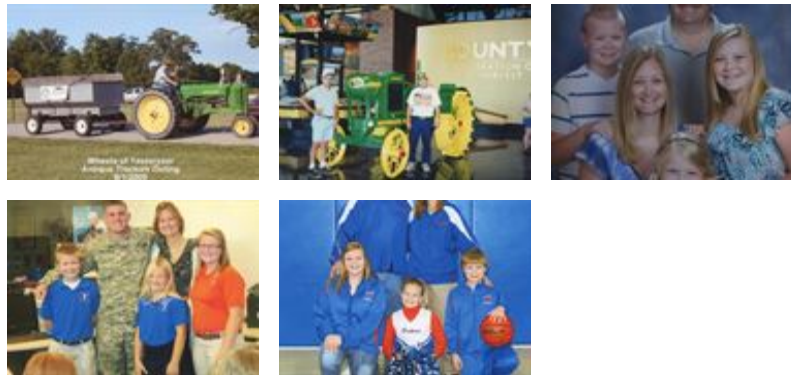

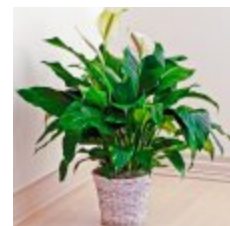
