



## Carl A. Green

January 18, 1931 - June 3, 2009

Carl A. Green 78 of Fort Wayne passed away at 12:05 a.m. Wednesday, June 3, 2009 at his residence in Fort Wayne.

Carl was born on January 18, 1931 in Bluffton, Indiana to Kenneth J. Green and Ocie Mae (Arthur) Green.

A 1948 graduate of Bluffton High School, Carl continued his education and graduated from the Elgin Watch College in 1949. He served his country in the United States Army from 1951 to 1953 during the Korean Conflict.

On September 19, 1954 in Bluffton, Indiana Carl married Armatha G. (Hook).

They have

been married for 54 years. She resides in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

He worked for 5 years as a watchmaker in Sidney, Ohio before joining Sears in Fort Wayne as a watchmaker and jeweler in 1959. He retired in 1993 as a Sales Manager for the Sears Store in Southtown Mall, after 34 years of service. He was a member of Waynedale United Methodist Church.

Other survivors include 3 sons, Mark A. (Carla Mathias) Green of West Lafayette, In, Gary M. (Linda Disher) Green, Sr. of Bluffton, In and Chad A. (Morgan Bron) Green of Chicago, IL. along with six grandchildren.

He is preceded in death by his parents, a daughter Karen Kay Green and a brother Robert L. Green in 1990, along with a grandson, Shelby Green and

great-grandson, Bailey Cuttier.

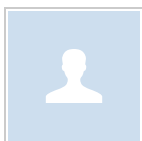
