



Carl Darrell Huffman

January 12, 1940 - October 13, 2010

Carl Darrell Huffman, 70, of Liberty Center, died at 12:56 p.m. Wednesday at Lutheran Hospital, Fort Wayne. Mr. Huffman, a lifelong resident of Wells County, was a 1958 graduate of Liberty Center and was a self-employed farmer. He drove a school bus for Southern Wells Community Schools for more than 25 years. He was the former owner and operator of the Huffman and Sons Gun Shop Inc. and was a fur buyer for 25 years. He was also the caretaker of the Mossburg Cemetery. He was a member of the Boehmer United Methodist Church and was a past member of the Odd Fellows Lodge and the Liberty Center Conservation Club. He was born Jan. 12, 1940, in Bluffton, to Clyde Huffman and Mary Thompson Huffman. He married Sara Tinkel March 20, 1960; his wife survives. Also surviving are three sons, C. Douglas (companion: Gloria) Huffman, Brian (Beverly) Huffman, and Mike (Lynne) Huffman, all of Liberty Center; six grandchildren, Tyler, Brett, Andrea, Kaitlyn, Blake, and Clay; and a brother, Dwight "Ike" Huffman of Liberty Center. Calling will be from noon to 8 p.m. Saturday and from noon to 2 p.m. Sunday at the Thoma/Rich, Chaney and Lemler Funeral Home.
