



Carl Leroy "Roy" Allen

July 31, 1909 - October 13, 2006

Funeral services for Carl Leroy "Roy" Allen, 97, will be at 1 p.m. Tuesday at Thoma/Rich, Hewitt & Chaney Funeral Home.

A former employee at Franklin Electric Co., and a farmer in Adams and Wells Counties, Mr. Allen died at 4:10 p.m. Friday, Oct. 13, 2006 at Goshen General Hospital.

He was a punch press operator at Franklin for 23 years and also farmed. He lived most of his life in Adams and Wells Counties before moving to Goshen in 1989. Mr. Allen was an avid fisherman and IU basketball fan.

Born July 31, 1909 in Alexandria to Charles A. and Bessie A. (Roby) Allen, his marriage on Feb. 15, 1934 in Hartford City was to Helen I. Keller, who preceded him in death in December of 1997.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Kenneth (Charlotte) Stuff of Elkhart; a son, Eugene (Gene) Allen of Bluffton; five grandchildren and nine great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a brother, Harry Allen and a sister, Ruth Settle.

Calling at the funeral home will be on Tuesday from 11 a.m. until time of services with Pastor Robert Schallhorn officiating. Burial will be in Stahl Cemetery.
