Carolyn J. Young, 71, of rural Bluffton, died at 3:45 p.m. Thursday, April 3, 2008, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center after an extended illness.

Born to Armer H. and Mabel E. (Scott) Brown on March 28, 1937, in Madison County, she married Edward D. Young in Jay County on Aug. 19, 1955. He preceded her in death on Aug. 2, 1996.

A 1955 graduate of Petroleum High School, she worked at the Wells Community Hospital for ten years, retiring in 1989. She also worked for Armstrong Glass Company in Dunkirk and for Meadowvale Health and Rehabilitation Center in Bluffton. She was a charter member of the Bluffton Wesleyan Chapel and instrumental in starting the church. She served in several ministries in the church and sang in a trio with her sisters.

Surviving are a brother, Richard L. Brown of Bluffton; and three sisters, Juanita Russell of Bluffton, Lois (Bill) Brickley of Bluffton and Marilyn (Keith) Meade of Bluffton.

She was preceded in death by a sister, La Vina L. Davis.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday at Thoma/Rich, Chaney & Lemler Funeral Home in Bluffton with Pastor Chad Clark officiating. Visitation will be from 3 p.m. to 9 p.m. today and 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday. Burial will be at I.O.O.F. Cemetery in Pennville.
