Charles William "Bill" McElhaney, 90, of Liberty Center passed away at 8:48 a.m. Tuesday at Heritage Pointe Retirement Community.

He was born in Wells County, Indiana on August 10, 1921 to Hugh V. and Nellie (Boltin) McElhaney. His parents preceded him in death. He married Mary Anna "Annie" (Leverton) on March 29, 1946 in Decatur, Indiana and she survives.

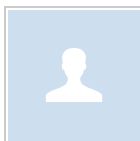

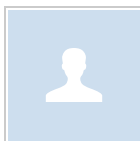

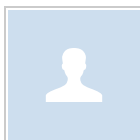
