Chris was born to Mary Bette and George M. Lewis in Lebanon Indiana. The family later moved to Bluffton Indiana. He was schooled in Bluffton graduating from Lancaster High School in 1958. He went on to attend Miami University studying geology and later switched to civil engineering at Purdue.

After graduation he joined the U.S. Navy and became a surveyor in the Sea Bees (CB). After his tours in Vietnam he returned home to Bluffton working as a surveyor with Ralph Higman. Chris took over the business after Ralph's passing. Chris had started to have health problems from toxic agents he was exposed to overseas. He was soon diagnosed with MS. He handled the diagnosis with courage and without complaint.

Chris was proud to serve. He was proud of Bluffton and Wells county. He was active with the Scouts as much as possible, liked to stop in the Elks to see what was up and was Commander of the Bluffton American Legion until his health made so much impossible. He will be greatly missed by those who were fortunate enough to know and love him.

He is survived by his brother Stephen (Kay) two nephews and nine grand nieces and nephews.

Graveside services and inurnment will be held Friday August 8 at 2:00 pm at Garden of the Chimes at Elm Grove Cemetery with Rev. Laura Sherwood
