Constance (Connie) Joan Nichter, 92, of Bluffton passed away on Monday morning, September 9, 2024, at Story Pointe – West, in Fort Wayne, surrounded by her family.

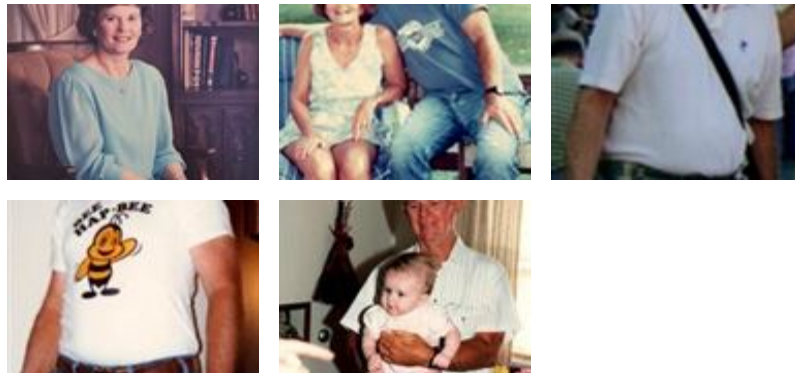
