Constance "Connie" Joan Sills, 71, of Bluffton, died at 9:45 p.m. Monday Dec. 10, 2007, at Ossian Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Born in Bluffton to Claude L. and Mary Jane (Stogdill) Sills on Jan. 31, 1936, she graduated from Wabash High School in 1954.

Mrs. Sills was an active member of Epworth United Methodist Church in Bluffton. She retired from the Wells County Treasurer's Office in 1998 after 23 years service. She continued to work at this office as needed during busy tax seasons however, and she was currently working at the Wells County Veteran's Service Office.
