May 5, 1932 - December 29, 2009

Dale Duane Krinn, 77, of Uniondale, passed away at 8:45 p.m., Tuesday, December 29, 2009 at his home.

Born May 5, 1932 in Wells County, to Harold M. and Mildred L. (Paxson) Krinn, he married Sally A. (Michael) in Uniondale, Indiana on July 21, 1957, she survives. Mr. Krinn was a resident of Wells County. He graduated from Bluffton High School in 1950 and served in the U.S. Air Force for four years during the Korean War. 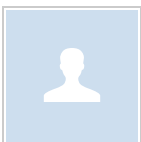
