



Daniel W. Frantz

October 3, 1939 - February 16, 2007

A lifelong resident of Wells County, Daniel W. Frantz, 67, of rural Liberty Center, died at 9 a.m. Friday, Feb. 16, 2007, at his home. He had been in failing health the last six months.

Mr. Frantz graduated from Liberty Center High School in 1957 and farmed until 1985. He worked several years with the Wells County Highway Department and owned and operated D. & J. Woodworks since 1997. He was in the Indiana National Guard from 1962 to 1968.

He served several years as an elder and deacon of the St. John United Church of Christ. He was a Liberty Center firefighter and a certified first responder for Wells Community Hospital for many years. He was a former member of the Bluffton Masonic Lodge.

Born Oct. 3, 1939, in Bluffton to Marion and Edna (Ware) Frantz, his marriage on Feb. 16, 1963, in Wells County was to Joyce E. Meyer, who survives.

In addition to his wife and mother, he is survived by two sons, Scott D. Frantz of Fishers and Steven W. Frantz of Somerset, Ky.; two daughters, Lisa Ann Frantz of Liberty Center and Mrs. Todd ("Diane" Kathleen) Rockwell of Poneto; two brothers, Larry Frantz of Eloy, Ariz., and Ted Frantz of Murfreesboro, Tenn.; and seven grandchildren. He was preceded in death by

a sister, Esther Kathleen "Kathy" (Frantz) Paxson.

Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday at St. John United Church of Christ with pastors Jim Mortemore, Don Miller and Rick Pulling officiating. Calling hours will be from noon to 6 p.m. Sunday at Thoma/Rich, Hewitt & Chaney Funeral Home and one hour prior to services Monday at the church. Burial will be at Six Mile Cemetery.
