Dennis A. Hendricks, 62, of Bluffton, died at 1:13 p.m. Monday, June 7, 2010, at his residence. Mr. Hendricks was born in Paxton, Ill. on April 15, 1948, to Willmer T. "Boe" and Evelyn M. (Lanhardt) Hendricks. He married Iris F. Driscoll in Bluffton on June 29, 1978; she preceded him in death on March 22, 2002.
