Doris A. Zoll, 75, of Bluffton, died at 2:20 p.m. Monday, Dec. 6, 2010, at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Mrs. Zoll worked at RCA in Marion before working at Corning Glass Works in Bluffton for 16 years. She worked at Keebler in Bluffton for 12 years, retiring in 1997.

She enjoyed teaching quilting and knitting classes at the Wells County Council on Aging. She also participated in the Senior Swim program at the Wells Community Pool.

She was born Sept. 1, 1935, at Hartford City, to Acel L. Wilcoxin and Ruth J. Pace Wilcoxin. She married Robert E. Zoll June 11, 1961, at Hartford City; her husband died Aug. 6, 1986.

Survivors include a son, Richard "Scott" (Lana) Zoll of Liberty Center; four daughters, Michel M. (Leroy) Jenkins of Noblesville, Ruth Ann Zoll of Bluffton, Andrea (Troy) Pulfer of Ossian, and Jonelle Gibson of Bluffton; and five grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren. In addition to her parents and her husband, she was preceded in death by a brother, William Eugene Wilcoxin.

Calling will be from 2 to 8 p.m. Friday and from noon to 6 p.m. Saturday at the Thomas/Rich, Chaney and Lemler Funeral Home. There will be no formal funeral services; cremation will follow calling hours.

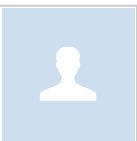
