Edward A. Dragoo, 77, of Bluffton, Indiana passed away at 11:00 A.M. Tuesday, June 16, 2009 at his home of natural causes. Born November 2, 1931 in Muncie, Indiana to Fred Dragoo and May Metzger, He married Doris West in Anderson, Indiana, November 12, 1954. His wife preceded him in death on September 23, 1988.
