Edwin D. Elzey, 82 of Tocsin, passed away at 7:59 a.m. Saturday, May 29, 2010 at his residence.

Mr. Elzey was born on January 6, 1928 in Wells County, Indiana to Jesse & Ethel (Hite) Elzey. He attended Lancaster and Bluffton Schools. In 1946 he enlisted and served his country in the United States Navy until he was discharged in 1947. On November 20, 1953 in Bluffton he married Betty L.
