Lena "Ellen" Reff, 95, of rural Bluffton, passed away peacefully on Thursday morning, September 19, 2024 at Lutheran Life Villages at Inverness in Fort Wayne. She was born on August 7, 1929, in Wells County to Paul and Mary (Dowty) Gilbert. She graduated from Rockcreek Center High School in 1947. On October 9, 1949, in Uniondale, Ellen and Harley "Wayne" Reff were married.

Together they operated the family dairy farm for 40 years. Ellen also worked as a part time accountant at the Brooks McCarty Accounting firm and Emshwiller & Emshwiller for 49 years.

She enjoyed her family and helping others. She was a long-time volunteer at the Bargain Hut and with Operation Christmas Child. She was an accomplished seamstress, cook and baker.
