May 18, 1926 - July 26, 2007

ERNEST "ERNIE" E. GODSEY, 81, of Bluffton, died Thursday, July 26, 2007, 11:50 p.m., at Bluffton Regional Medical Center. Born May 18, 1926, in Yamacraw, Ky., he was the son of the late Walker Godsey and Ada (White) Godsey. He married his first wife, Christine (Upchurch) on April 23, 1945, in Newport, Ky.; she died on Dec. 6, 1990. He married his second wife, Norma (Zimmerman) Breedlove on July 13, 1991, in Liberty Center, Ohio. He worked in the maintenance department at Dyster, Fort Wayne, retiring in 1976. He moved from Kentucky to Ohio, in 1944, and then to Indiana, in 1970. He also worked as a metal finisher at Fort Recovery for 17 years and for 12 years at Nutone Corp., Cincinnati, Ohio. He also worked as a landscaper in Fort Wayne for four years. He was a member of Mulberry Street Wesleyan Church. In the early years, he sang in a family group "The Upchurch Family Group" and then later sang with the "Northmen". Surviving are his wife of 17 years, Norma; daughters, Mrs. Vernon (Judy) Baker of Fort Wayne and Mrs. Jeff (Helen) Gallant of Ossian; son, Alan (Cathy) Godsey of Fort Wayne; stepdaughter, Mrs. Sharon Binegar of Fiat; stepsons, David Breedlove of Dickinson, Texas, Richard Breedlove of Fort Wayne and Tom Breedlove of Bluffton; stepdaughters, Mrs. Tim (Joyce) Mayer of Bluffton and Mrs. Janice Miller of Vevay, Ind.; 17 grandchildren; 23 great-grandchildren; five great-great-grandchildren; sister, Mrs. Addie Bullock of Whitley City, Ky.; and brothers, Arthur (Ernie's twin) and Richard, and Kelly Godsey.
