Ernie W. Dohrman 83 of Bluffton passed away Thursday morning February 3, 2022 at Markle Health and Rehabilitation Center. 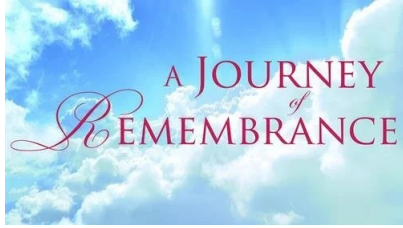
