Eunice E. Haifley, 91, of Bluffton, died at 4:25 a.m. Monday, Oct. 27, 2008, at Christian Care Retirement Community.

Born in Vera Cruz on Aug. 23, 1917 to Carl R. and Maude (Maddeux) Dilley, she married William E. Haifley in Bluffton on Jan. 1, 1938. He preceded her in death on Dec. 10, 2002.

Mrs. Haifley was a homemaker and long time member and past president of the local chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. Along with her husband, she formed the first archery club in Wells County. For many years she was Floral Judge for the Bluffton Street Fair Association. She was a past president and long time member of the Wells County Garden Club, and a member of the United Methodist Women in Bluffton.

Surviving relatives include two daughters, Heather (Thomas) Meisch of Ossian and Linda (William) Fronk of Leawood, Kan.; one son, Tom Haifley of Greensboro N.C.; one sister, Sarah F. McKinney of Bluffton; nine grandchildren and 15 great grandchildren.

Mrs. Haifley was also preceded in death by four sisters.
