Frances M. Mossburg, 77, of Liberty Center, died at 2:10 a.m. Monday, May 16, 2011, at Warren United Methodist Home.

Mrs. Mossburg was born in Limestone County, Alabama, on Jan. 4, 1934 to Albert B. and Rosalie Ann (Pope) Macklin. She married Robert E. Mossburg in Simms on Oct. 14, 1950. They shared 40 years of marriage together before he preceded her in death on Dec. 7, 1990.

Mrs. Mossburg was a homemaker, and also worked in the kitchen at Meadowvale Health and Rehabilitation Center from 1978, retiring in 2000. She was a member of Liberty Center United Methodist Church, where she was active a member of the United Methodist Women. She was also in the U.Y.B. Home Ec. Club.

Surviving relatives include two sons, Rodney E. (Deb) Mossburg and John L. (Christine) Mossburg, both of Liberty Center; one daughter, Cindy Richardson of Warren; two sisters, Mary Shelton of Alabama and Artie (husband Ed) Gaither of Jonesboro; 10 grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Mossburg was also preceded in death by two sons, Randy and Mark Mossburg, one daughter, Sharon Mossburg; two sisters, Elaine Beatty and Anna Trisler; and one brother, Marvin Macklin.
