



Frederick W. "Fred" Murray

March 11, 1940 - September 16, 2021

Frederick W. "Fred" Murray 81, of Bluffton passed away Thursday evening September 16, 2021 at his home surrounded by his family. Fred was born March 11, 1940 in Bluffton to the late Wayne and Ruth L. (Jarrett) Murray. Fred was a 1958 graduate of Bluffton High School. He graduated in 1966 from Ball State University with a bachelor's degree and a master's degree in Education. He was a Social Studies teacher for the 7th and 8th grade at the Bluffton Middle School for 35 years. Fred was instrumental in starting the 7th and 8th grade Boys Basketball program at Bluffton. He coached high school basketball and baseball. His most memorable coaching moments were being able to coach his son Jason. He was the head coach of Bluffton Baseball when they won their first Sectional Championships in 1970 and 1972. Fred was a longtime member of the Bluffton Elks Lodge, ISTA and NEA. He was instrumental in starting the Elks #796 Golf Scholarship. He had attended First Reformed Church.

On October 18, 1969 in Bluffton, Fred married Trudy L. Starr. They have shared 51 years of marriage.

Survivors include his wife Trudy L. Murray of Bluffton, IN, Jenny Merica of Russiaville, IN, Jason (Mindy) Murray of Mount Pleasant, SC, and three granddaughters Hannah and Hilary Merica and Mya Murray. He is also survived by his brother Jerry K. (Lois) Murray.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

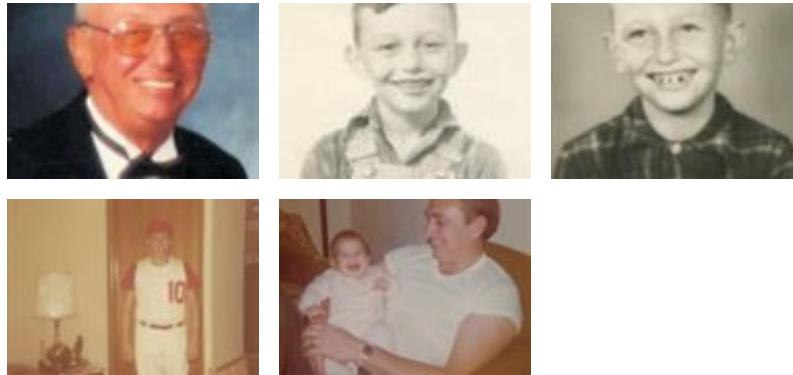
