George B. Green, 81, Bluffton, died at 10:15 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 8, 2008, at River Terrace Estates in Bluffton. Born in Wells County on Nov. 24, 1926 to Robert B. and Mary E. (Ramsey) Green, he married Betty J. Moore on Aug. 9, 1947 in Fort Wayne. His wife survives. A 1944 graduate of Lancaster High School, he served in the U.S. Navy during World War II. He was a life-long resident of Wells County. He retired in 1986 from Franklin Electric as a personnel supervisor, working there 37 years. After retirement, he worked refinishing furniture for many people. He enjoyed sports and watching his grandchildren participate in them. He was a member of the American Legion Post 111 in Bluffton and a long-time member of the Parlor City Country Club. Other survivors include two sons, Terry (Nancy) Green of Sparta, Wisc. and Gary "Mick" (Julia) Green of Lafayette; two daughters, Tamra (Leon) Berning of Uniondale and Glenda Stoppenhagen of Ossian; two brothers, Robert Green of Bluffton and Roger Green of Fort Wayne; three sisters, Ruth Ann Haneline of Bluffton, Marjorie Grothaus of Fort Wayne, and Evelyn Gaiser of Fort Walton Beach, Fla.; and nine grandchildren, three step-grandchildren; 12 great grandchildren, and five step-great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a sister, Sue Maddox.

Services will be held Thursday at 10:30 a.m. at Thoma/ Rich, Chaney & Lemler Funeral Home with Tony Garton officiating. Calling hours are Wednesday from 2 to 8 p.m. and Thursday for one hour prior to the service.

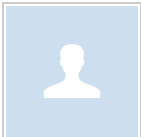

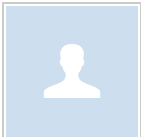
