Gerald "Slug" W. King, 79 of Vera Cruz, passed away early Sunday morning, May 30, 2021, at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

“ I have heard the name Slug King since the 7th grade He was a few years older than I but he had one of those names.....Even If you didn't know him, you knew of him. I have heard stories from some of the best athletes in BHS history about just how good he was in football.....He and George Gehrett. They were rough, tough customers and both were sittin on go, waitin on ready. I and some of my friends always walked to Wilson Field on Friday nights for the home football games and could hear the PA all over the west end of town. One time we were maybe 20 minutes late and hurrying to get there when the PA boomed about who was being ejected from the game It was still the 1st quarter.....seems there had been a disagreement. Two players from the other team ejected and two from Bluffton.....George and Slug. They both dropped out of football and at some point I think, even school. They were both victims of a failed school system that cared little about students not considered elite or “college” prepped. That's just how it was in those days. Every year when I read of the newest inductees into the BHS athlete Hall of Fame I think of guys like Slug and George. Maybe with just a little bit of encouragement?
