Gladys H. Crump, 94 of Bluffton passed away at 5:50 a.m. Thursday, May 14, 2015, at River Terrace Estates in Bluffton.

Gladys was born on June 12, 1920 in Wausau, Wisconsin to Frank & Ida (Kuntz) Tremel. On April 3, 1937 in Wausau, Gladys and Lyle J. Crump were married. They shared 65 years together before Lyle preceded her in death on March 4, 2002. A homemaker, Gladys and Lyle moved to Bluffton in July of 1952. She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church and a member of the Bluffton Moose and Elks Lodge.
