Glenneveer “Glenny” M. Grim, 89, of Bluffton went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Monday morning, March 10, 2014 at River Terrace Estates in Bluffton.

Glenny was born on September 24, 1924 in Linn Grove, Indiana to Alva & Golda (Roth) Smith. She graduated from Lancaster High School with the class of 1943. In her early years she was active in her dad’s campaign for sheriff of Wells County. She worked at General Electric in Fort Wayne and retired from Franklin Electric in Bluffton in 1985 after 30 years of service.

On November 8, 1947 in Bluffton, Glenny and Harold S. Grim were married. They shared 62 years of marriage before Harold preceded her in death on November 13, 2009. She and Harold spent many happy years at Jellystone Campground before retiring. They enjoyed spending the last 22 years wintering in Florida.

A lifelong resident of Wells County, she was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary #111 for over 75 years and an active member of the Red Hats Society at River Terrace. River Terrace became a final address where she had many beloved friends and where she enjoyed playing cards and other activities.
