Harold R. Meyer 84, passed away November 23, 2009 at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Born in Wells County on December 2, 1924 to Joseph and Adella Meyer. He was married to Elizabeth Dunwiddie on August 31, 1952. Harold worked at General Electric for 13 years and retired from the Bluffton Post Office after 30 years. Harold spent 3 years in the Army and was in 5 major battles during the Korean War and received 5 Battle Stars and a major citation from the Korean government. He belonged to the American Legion Post 111. Harold served as a volunteer at Christian Care Retirement Center for 18 years. Harold was a member of the Berne Evangelical Church. During his life he served in several positions at the church.

Surviving are his wife Elizabeth, four sons, Rodney (Carol) of Albany, IN, Bruce (Melody), Gregory (Sara) of Berne, IN, and Randy (Fran) of Round Lake Beach, IL. There are also six grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. One brother, Don of Fort Wayne. Harold was preceded in death by two brothers and one sister.
