Harold S. Grim, 87, of Bluffton, died at 10:35 a.m. on Friday, Nov. 13, 2009, at River Terrace Estates. Mr. Grim was born in Tocsin on July 18, 1922 to Orville and Vivian (Prough) Grim. He married Glenneveer Smith in Bluffton on Nov. 8, 1947; she survives. A graduate of Ossian High School, Mr. Grim served in the U.S. Army during World War II and was a prisoner of war. He was a member of the American Legion Post #111, V.F.W. Post and X-P.O.W.'s of America. Harold was a welder at Fruehauf Trailer Company for 33 years before retiring in 1984. He was a lifelong resident of Wells County and wintered in Florida for 22 years. He loved his country and was a loving husband, father and grandfather. He always had a smile for everyone. Surviving relatives also include one daughter, Rebecca (Steven) Watson of Warsaw; one brother, John (Marty) Grim of Tocsin; four grandchildren, Brian Staub of Fort Wayne, Mark Staub of Fort Wayne, Nicole Arrendale of Indianapolis and Curtis Watson of California.
