



Harry "Haddie" Oliver Jr.

May 19, 1936 - February 17, 2017

Harry "Haddie" Oliver, Jr., 80, of Bluffton passed away at 7:45 a.m. Friday, February 17, 2017, at his residence, surrounded by his family.

Haddie was born on May 19, 1936 in Bluffton to Harry Oliver & Flossie May (Shannon) Oliver. He graduated from Bluffton High School in 1954. He was a truck driver and a member of the Teamsters Union. Haddie drove for B & L. Motor Freight of Newark, Ohio and retired driving for Complete Auto Transit of Dayton, Ohio, in 1992. He was a member and treasurer of the Elks Lodge #796 in Bluffton.

On September 2, 1959 in Bluffton, Haddie & Patty J. (Lockwood) were married.

Survivors include his wife, Patty, of 57 years of Bluffton along with two daughters; Shelley (Michael) Mossburg of Bluffton and Sandra Shady of Fort Wayne. He was a proud grandpa to 4 grandchildren: Stephanie (fiancé Adam Dennis) Shady of New Haven and Nicholas Shady of Fort Wayne and Chelsea & Olivia Mossburg of Bluffton, along with a great-grandson Leo Dennis of New Haven.

He is preceded in death by his parents and siblings; Leon Oliver, LaVonna Blem, Ronald Lee Oliver, Donald D. Oliver and Martha "Rosie" Oliver-Alspach.
