



Harry M. "Mick" Miller

Harry M. "Mick" Miller, 80, of Bluffton, died at 10:17 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 12, 2007, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Born in Wells County to Eugene and Louise (Votaw) Miller on Dec. 29, 1926, Mr. Miller married Marcella "Becky" Brown on Aug. 7, 1976 in Ohio; she survives.

A 1947 graduate of Bluffton High School, Mr. Miller served in the U.S. Navy from January 1944 to August 1952. He operated Miller's Body Shop for 10 years prior to working at Corning Glass Works from 1964 to 1983 in the maintenance and tool and die shops. He then worked at Chrysler in Kokomo until his retirement in 1991. Mr. Miller was a member of American Legion Post 111.

Other surviving relatives include two daughters, Constance (Barry) Duncan of Bluffton and Teresa (Charles) Mosure of Poneto; two sons, Kenneth E. (Louise) Miller of Bluffton and David M. (Emily) Miller of Hope; two step-children, Howard Bennett of Bluffton and Michele Lightle also of Bluffton; one brother, Robert Miller of rural Zanesville; 10 grandchildren and 16 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a sister, Carol Clifton.

Funeral services will be at 1 p.m. Sunday at the Thoma/Rich, Hewitt & Chaney Funeral Home with the Rev. James Poling officiating. Calling hours will be from 2 to 8 p.m. Saturday at the funeral home. Burial will be at Six Mile Cemetery. Military graveside honors will be performed by American Legion

Post 111 of Bluffton and the U.S. Navy Honor Guard.
