June 22, 1923 - December 19, 2010

Helen E. Glass, 87, of Liberty Center, died at 8:26 a.m. Sunday, Dec. 19, 2010, at the Heritage Pointe Retirement Community in Warren. Mrs. Glass was a lifelong resident of Wells County and was the valedictorian of the Liberty Center High School Class of 1941. She assisted on the family farm and also volunteered for many years at Southern Wells Elementary School. She was a member of the Liberty Center United Methodist Church. She was born June 22, 1923, at Liberty Center, to Frank Ware and Flora Loretta Osborn Ware. She married John A. Glass in October of 1941 at Liberty Center; her husband died July 24, 1999. Survivors include two sons, Norman (Dianne) Glass of Berne and Ervin (Brenda) Glass of Fort Wayne; a daughter, Karen (Don) Hatch of Marion; six grandchildren, Scott Hatch of Philadelphia, Pa., Wendy Hatch of Fort Wayne, Rachelle Eisenmann of Decatur, Heather Frank of Ossian, Angela Blinkiewicz of Lebanon, Ohio, and Shannon Glass of Albion; six great-grandchildren; and a sister, Joyce (Rex) Gregg of Bluffton.
