May 23, 1916 - October 31, 2007

Helen Berniece Slusher, 91, of Bluffton, died at 4:20 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 31, 2007, at River Terrace Estates.

Born in Kingsland to Lorenzo and Catherine (Dishong) Kahn on May 23, 1916, she married Roscoe Slusher in Kentucky in 1931; he preceded her in death on Nov. 21, 1975.

Mrs. Slusher attended Lancaster School and was a homemaker, farmer, and had also worked at Appliance Manufacturing and Corning Glass.

Surviving relatives include one daughter, Donna Jean McFarland of Bluffton; one son, Don Slusher of Warren; five grandchildren, nine great-grandchildren and three great-great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Slusher was preceded in death by two brothers, Bill and Clarence Kahn, and two sisters, Nellie Smeltzer and Erma Bailer.
