Herman M. Barcus, 95 of Bluffton passed away at 11:00 p.m. Monday, January 27, 2014 at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Mr. Barcus was born on October 15, 1918 in Liberty Township, Wells County to William E. Barcus & Lillie (Morris) Barcus. He graduated from Liberty Center High School with the class of 1936. On January 21, 1939 he married Edith (Williamson) Barcus. They have shared the last 75 years together.

Herman was a lifelong farmer in Wells County and worked for the Railway Express for over 10 years. He was a member of the Liberty Center United Methodist Church where he sang in the choir and held many offices as Sunday School Superintendent. 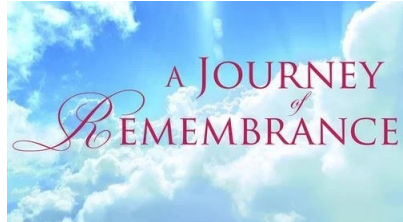
Funeral services will be held at 10:30 on Saturday at the Thoma/Rich, Chaney
