Ida Mae Ramseyer, 89, of Ossian, died at 8:30 p.m. Saturday, July 12, 2008, at Ossian Health Care.

Born in Wells County on Sept. 17, 1918 to Stanford and Mollie (Moore) Osborn, she married Alfred F. Ramseyer in Blackford County on Dec. 12, 1936; he preceded her in death on March 14, 1973.

Mrs. Ramseyer attended Liberty Center School. She was a homemaker and also worked for 28 years in the housekeeping department at Wells Community Hospital. She was a member of Blanche Chapel Church and attended Petroleum United Methodist Church.
