Jack K. Bowen, 78, of Rockford, Ohio, died at 11:29 p.m. Monday, Dec. 28, 2009, at Parkview Hospital in Fort Wayne. Mr. Bowen was born in Bluffton on Sept. 22, 1931 to Lloyd and Justine (Sawyer) Bowen. A graduate of Bluffton High School, Mr. Bowen was a U.S. Army veteran who served in the Korean War. He worked as a factory worker at Aero Quip in Van Wert, Ohio, and owned three restaurant/bars in his lifetime including the Pirate's Cove in Ligonier. He attended the First Christian Church. Jack loved growing roses, golfing and fishing. Surviving relatives include one daughter, Pam K. 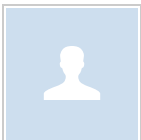
