James V. Brinneman, Sr., 80, of Bluffton, passed away Monday evening, March 4, 2019, at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Fort Wayne. 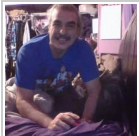

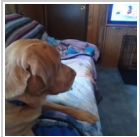
