James M. "Jim" Parker, 91, of Bluffton, passed away at 4:50 p.m., Thursday, February 21, 2013 at River Terrace Estates.

Jim was born in Bluffton on December 27, 1921 to William and Christina (Elzey) Parker. He married Juanita J. (Alberson) in Petroleum, Indiana on August 7, 1946. She preceded him in death on December 11, 2004.

Jim graduated from Bluffton High School in 1942 and was a life-long resident of Wells County. He was a U.S. Air Force World War II veteran. He was a member of Bluffton Masonic Lodge #145 F.&A.M. and a former member of American Legion Post #111. Jim, along with his wife owned & operated the Vogue Shop in Bluffton from 1960 to 1983.
