James A. "Jim" McBride, 88, of Bluffton passed away at 4:15 p.m. Friday, May 27, 2011 at his home.

Jim was born in Bluffton, Indiana on February 28, 1923 to William W. and Korah (Roach) McBride, they preceded him in death.

Jim married Carolyn (Motz) on December 21, 1952 in Bluffton and she survives.

Jim graduated from Bluffton High School in 1942. He then studied funeral service and graduated from the Indiana School of Mortuary Science in Indianapolis. He practiced as a funeral director for 25 years with McBride & Sons Funeral Home. Jim also served as the Wells County Juvenile Probation Officer, and worked for Adams-Wells Special Services before retiring in 1985. Jim enjoyed reading , fishing , and traveling.

Jim was a World War II Veteran having served as a U.S. Navy Corpsman attached to the U.S. Marine Corps. He was an active member of the First Baptist Church where he was baptized in 1952.
